


# HOW DOES THE CITY OF OAKALND FUND VIOLENCE PREVENTION IN OUR COMMUNITY?

## Oakland City Budget

FY 2020-21



Oakland voters approved **Measure Z, The Safety & Services Act of 2014** which uses the revenue from parking and parcel taxes to fund violence prevention programs and police staffing. It was preceded by **Measure Y, The Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004**.

*The City of Oakland funds other programs to reduce violence that are not part of Measure Z*

## Measure Z budget

FY 2020-2021

Funding from Measure Z is allocated across multiple departments that work with community organizations to intervene before crimes occur and to address contributing factors of poverty and inequality.
